

20 Foundational Genesis Questions

This question set is for the 2011-2012 Season

Question: Question 1 for 10 points.

How long did it rain at the beginning of the great flood?

(Gen 7: 12 “and rain fell upon the earth forty days and forty nights.”)

Question: Question 2 for 10 points. Give a complete answer.

According to Genesis 9:3 what did God give to man?

(Gen 9:3 “Everything that lives and moves will be food for you. Just as I gave you the green plants, I now give you everything.”)

Question: Question 3 for 10 points.

According to Genesis, how many years did Noah live after the flood?

(Gen 9:28 Noah lived 350 years after the flood)

Question: Question 4 for 10 points. Give a complete answer.

What came out of the ark?

(Gen 8:19 “All the animals and all the creatures that move along the ground and all the birds—everything that moves on the earth—came out of the ark, one kind after another.”)

Question: Question 5 for 10 points.

Where was the Tower of Babel built?

(Gen 11:2 A plain in the land of Shinar)

Question: Question 6 for 10 points. Two part question, three part answer.

What two birds did Noah send out and which one returned with something?

(Gen 8:7, 8 & 11 a raven and a dove; “When the dove returned to him in the evening, there in its beak was a freshly plucked olive leaf!”)

Question: Question 7 for 10 points.

Who planted the Garden of Eden?

(Gen 2:8 God)

Question: Question 8 for 10 points.

What was created on day 1 of creation?

(Gen 1:5 Day and Night, **or** Light and Darkness **or** evening and morning)

Question: Question 9 for 10 points. Give a complete answer.

Describe the earth before creation?

(Gen 1:2 “The earth was without form and void, and darkness was over the surface of the deep, and the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters.”)

Question: Question 10 for 10 points. Give a complete answer.

How did God remove the flood waters?

(Gen 8:1-2 “But God remembered Noah and all the wild animals and the livestock that were with him in the ark, and he sent a wind over the earth, and the waters receded. 2 Now the springs of the deep and the floodgates of the heavens had been closed, and the rain had stopped falling from the sky.”)

Question: Question 11 for 10 points. Quotation question.

Quote Genesis 8:22

(Gen 8:22 “While the earth remains, seedtime and harvest, cold and heat, summer and winter, day and night shall not cease.”)

Question: Question 12 for 10 points.

Where did Noah’s ark rest after the flood?

(Gen 8:4 the mountains of Ararat)

Question: Question 13 for 10 points. 3 part answer.

What was created on day 3 of creation?

(Gen 1:9-11 land (or earth) and seas and vegetation)

Question: Question 14 for 10 points. 2 part answer.

According to Gen 8:21, What did God say He would never do again?

(Gen 8:21 “Never again will I curse the ground because of man, even though every inclination of his heart is evil from childhood. And never again will I destroy all living creatures, as I have done.”)

Question: Question 15 for 10 points. Give a complete answer.

What did God say the people and the animals were to do after being released from the ark?

(Gen 8:17 “Bring out every kind of living creature that is with you—the birds, the animals, and all the creatures that move along the ground—so they can multiply on the earth and be fruitful and increase in number upon it.”)

Question: Question 16 for 10 points.

After being cursed by God, in what land did Cain live?

(Gen 4:16 the land of Nod which was east of Eden)

Question: Question 17 for 10 points.

What was created on day 5 of creation?

(Gen 1:20-21 Birds and fish (or sea creatures))

Question: Question 18 for 10 points. Quotation question.

Quote Genesis 4:6-7?

(Gen 4:6,7 “Then the LORD said to Cain, “Why are you angry? Why is your face downcast? If you do what is right, will you not be accepted? But if you do not do what is right, sin is crouching at your door; it desires to have you, but you must master it.”)

Question: Question 19 for 20 points.

God instructed Noah to build the ark with what dimensions?

(Gen 6:15 450 feet long, 75 feet wide and 45 feet high)

Question: Question 20 for 30 points.

According to Genesis chapter 6, how many people survived the flood?

(Gen 6:18 Eight; Noah and his wife, their three sons and their three wives)
